## Lacy Tree Philodendron

**Philodendron selloum**

*Ideal for beginners, the Philodendron tends to adapt easily to its surroundings. Its foliage is as interesting as Monstera. Young leaves are pale tender green. As they grow, these have an irregular shape that will make your plant stand out in your decor. A bright place will make them happy, without exposing them to direct sunlight. It's important to let the soil dry out slightly between each watering, especially in winter.*



**CULTURAL PRACTICES:** Fill your tray with a regular sowing soil. Place the seeds on the soil and cover with vermiculite and water. Cover your tray with a plastic dome to promote a constant humid environment. The ideal temperature for your seedlings is +/- 23 degrees.

**SOIL:** Sowing: regular sowing soil. Transplantation: interior soil.

**GROWING TIPS:** Germination takes about 15 days. Two weeks before potting, bring the temperature down to 17 degrees.
