Larger Blue-Flag

Iris versicolor



PLANTATION: lightly abrade the seed coats by rubbing seeds between two sheets of sandpaper. Bring water to a boil for 5 minutes. Pour over seeds and let soak for 24 hours. Mix seeds with an equal amount of damp sand or vermiculite. Place the mixture in a sealed plastic bag. Store the bag in a refrigerator or cool storage room for 90 days. Sow seeds when there is no risk of ground frost.

SOIL: cool, moist or water soaked

CULTURALS PRACTICES: or plant the seeds outdoors during the fall. Germination will occur the following spring or later on.
