

Trifolium repens –White clover

White clover seeds are known for their high resistance to drought and to grubs that destroy lawns. Ideal for lawns in shady or sunny locations, white clover remains compact, does not require mowing and produces white flowers.

Characteristics White clover easily adapts to all soil types and remains a lush green even during drought.

Use To use as pure seeds or in mixture with grass seeds.

Coverage Bag of 250 grams covers :
Pure seed: 25 m² (250 square feet).
In mixture with grass seed: 250 grams of clover mixed with 6.25 kg of grass seeds cover 233 m² (2330 square feet). 4% of clover in the mix

Application rate Using a spreader, apply half the white clover seeds lengthwise, then the other half widthwise. Sowing season Spring (April-May) or Fall (August-September).
