## RADISH-CHERRY BELLE

**CULTURAL PRACTICES:** Seed ribbons - presumed We invite you to discover the range of "presemés": it is seeds arranged between two very thin layers of biodegradable fibers. In this way, they are exactly at the right density and you do not overdose your seedlings. In addition, nothing more simple: make a little furrow, lay down the pre-cut ribbon to the required length, moisture it and cover it with a thin layer of soil. Water. Wait. Admire. Easy no?

**SOIL:** the ideal temperature for growth is 10 ° C to 18 ° C in fertile soil.

**SPACING:** Sow them in rows 45 cm to 50 cm apart and thin them to 2.5 - 5 cm.

**GROWING TIPS:** maintaining humidity is important because they will grow fast and taste better. They tolerate partial shade. They can also be sown with slower growing vegetables to define the rows.

**HARVEST:** harvest the radishes when they have reached the desired size. However, do not let them get too big, this will affect their taste and make them harder and more fibrous.
