Digitalis

PLANTATION: It is suggested to sow 8-10 weeks before planting outside. Keep the temperature around 15-18 °C. Germination time is between 10-12 days. Plant the seeds in a container because transplantation is delicate, it must be done by without disturbing the roots as little as possible.

SOIL: A well-drained, porous sowing media is best to prevent over watering.

CULTURALS PRACTICES: Its flowers in the first year without vernalization. The foxglove has a biennial vegetative cycle. This means that the plant lives 2 years on average and then dies. The first year, the plant thrives and makes a first flower stalk. During summer, the rosette branches out; the plant can reach 60 cm in diameter with several rosettes. In the following spring the flowering is then grandiose, very tall with multiple stems. Usually, the plant then dies.
