PLANTATION: Indoor: It is suggested to sow 8-10 weeks before planting outside. Keep the temperature around 18-21 °C. Germination time is between 8-14 days. **Outdoor:** Forget-me-nots can be sown indoors or in a nursery, either in August, in place, for flowering the following year.

SOIL: **Indoor**: Well-drained, porous seedling soil to prevent overwatering. **Outdoor**: cool humus soil.

CULTURALS PRACTICES: Forget-me-nots reseed themselves and can become very invasive. Forget-me-nots can be sown indoors or in a nursery, in August, in place, for flowering the following year. The seedlings in the nursery are transplanted, then, in the fall or the following spring. The best time to plant is, however, the fall. Plants planted during this period have more time to form their root system. The secrets of its success are the sun, without too much heat - a semi-shaded location is perfectly fine - and rather cool humus soil.
