PLANTATION: Indoor: It is suggested to sow 6-8 weeks before planting outside. Keep the temperature around 20 °C. Germination time is around 7days.

SOL: **Indoor:** Well-drained, porous seedling soil to prevent

overwatering.

Outdoor: Well-drained soil.

CULTURALS PRACTICES: Calaminthas are perennials that tolerate temperatures down to -24 °C. Ideal in sunny and shady places and in the undergrowth, it requires a humus and well-drained soil. It can give a beautiful flowering plant of 60 cm in all directions if the soil is richer, without its stems shedding. Its stems die off in the winter, and the stump is cleaned of its old, dry stems in the spring, low above the new emerging leaves.
