PLANTATION: Indoor: It is suggested to sow 6 weeks before planting outside. Keep the temperature around 22 °C. Germination time is between 5-15 days.

Outdoor: Direct sowing in the fall.

Note: Do not cover the seeds, they need light to germinate.

SOL: Indoor: Well-drained, porous seedling soil to prevent overwatering.

Outdoor: Well-drained soil.

CULTURALS PRACTICES: It is easy to grow, thriving in any well-drained soil with average moisture and full sun. This species requires deadheading to promote continuous blooming. It can be propagated either by seed or by division in early spring, and this should be done every two to three years.

This beautiful, heat-tolerant plant will finish quickly to form a well-branched and floriferous habit. Prune faded flowers to prolong flowering. Clean the foliage in the spring.
