Celery



CULTURAL PRACTICES: sow indoors in early March in light, sandy soil, cover the seeds with three millimeters of soil. There will be germination after three weeks at a temperature of 17 ° C. Transplant into individual pots when the plants are 2.5 cm high.

SOIL: rich in organic matter.

SPACING: at the end of May, place in the garden at a distance of 20 to 30 cm between the plants in rows spaced at least 60 cm apart.

GROWING TIPS: mulching in order to reduce weed growth and maintain moisture, care must be taken to ensure that the soil is not constantly wet.

HARVEST: cut the entire plant at ground level before the seeds appear, or cut the stems on the periphery as and when required.
