CULTURAL PRACTICES: the leek has a slow vegetative development. Sow it indoors in early March, thinning out too dense seedlings. When the foliage of the leek seedlings reaches 6 to 8 cm in length, cut off the ends so that the plants grow larger.

SOIL: very rich, very deep, well exposed to the sun.

SPACING: Transplant them into the garden as soon as the soil allows (12 $^{\circ}$ C), spacing them 10-15 cm and 25 cm between the rows.

GROWING TIPS: Transplant them into the garden as soon as the soil allows (12 ° C), spacing them 10-15 cm and 25 cm between the rows.

HARVEST: pluck the leeks, shake the earth, cut the roots to 1 cm and shorten the leaves.
