## NION-BUNCHING

**CULTURAL PRACTICES:** sow indoors in early April or directly in the garden as soon as the soil is working well.

**SOIL:** they need rich and fertile soil (mineral or organic soil). It should be kept moist but not wet.

**SPACING:** the row spacing is 35 cm to 38 cm. For larger bulbs, thin out plants to 7cm to 8cm. The removed plants are delicious in salads.

**GROWING TIPS:** it is recommended to add fertilizer at the start of the crop and again when the bulbs start to swell.

**HARVEST:** harvest after five to six weeks, the green onion stalks will measure 6 to 8 inches and will be ready to eat. Harvest them by pulling on the stems to tear off the entire plant.
