CULTURAL PRACTICES: onion seeds should be sown indoors in February.

SOIL: they need rich and fertile soil (mineral or organic soil). It should be kept moist but not wet.

SPACING: the row spacing is 35 cm to 38 cm. For larger bulbs, thin out plants to 7cm to 8cm. The removed plants are delicious in salads.

GROWING TIPS: it is recommended to add fertilizer at the start of the crop and again when the bulbs start to swell.

HARVEST: harvest the onions when the leaves droop, turn brown and dry out. Drying can be speeded up by folding a few leaves. Once, harvest, put the onions in a dry, warm and well ventilated place. They keep in a cool, dry room.
